QEBF TOURNAMENT RULES

ratified AGM 11/12/2011

GENERAL

1 To be eligible for State events a player must be **registered** with QEBF and have played **50%** of matches available in Association fixtures for the **event calendar year**.

Newcomers must play 50% of available matches since registration -- **minimum** 5 fixtures.

2. The **dress code** applies to all QEBF events: collared shirt, black covered dress shoes, black dress slacks/skirt.

3 Participants in State events will be required to **referee** matches according to the tournament schedule.

4 **Match Play:** Players/teams will **forfeit 1 frame for each 5 minutes** lapsed after call to a scheduled table by a tournament official. Match forfeit will occur after 20 minutes.

Round Robin: Players will **forfeit frame/s when 5 minutes** have lapsed from call to a scheduled table by a tournament official.

Players will **forfeit their round robin place** when the **second 5 minutes** have lapsed from call to a scheduled table by a tournament official.

Players will **forfeit their round robin place** if the 5 minute call is missed at any **later stage in the event**.

If a player continues the round robin at the second call, initial frame/s missed are played for the overall result. Frame/s are deducted from the offender's final score.

5 Players in all State events must **not play lower** than their Association grade of that year, which should be the same as that played for the previous year unless they were relegated by Association rules (usually less than 30% for previous year).

6. Once a player completes his/her **third fixture in a higher grade** he/she must **remain** in that grade, and **cannot** compete in fixtures or State events in his/her previous grade for that year.

7. Once commencing an event, players must **complete any round robin** schedule unless extreme circumstances prevail.

Penalty: a fine of \$50 payable to the QEBF (or the Zone), or forfeiture of entry to any state event.

Repeat offenders within a three year period incur a suspension for one calendar year from all QEBF events.

STATE SQUAD AND MAJOR EVENTS

1. **Seeds to State events** will be allocated to the zones on a **pro rata system** based on registration for the current year.

2. To be eligible for State squad playoffs a player must **qualify through the ranking point system**, unless special permission is granted by the QEBF committee. (State squad = 24 for, 28 for Women, 2012)

3. **Senior** players who make **medal selection and play** in the Australian Open and Women's team at the World Titles gain **automatic entry to the Zone squad** for that year.

4. **Singles champions** gain automatic entry to the **State team** for that year. **QEBF pays** entry to Aust. Singles.

5. **Reserve places** for the State team (Open 10-15, Women 8-9, Masters 5-6) will be filled by the reserve players in order from the State squad trials. Position 16 in the Open, 9 in the Women and 6 in the Masters will be filled by the managers if squad qualified.

These reserve players for the State team **do not play** in the team event at the National Titles (barring an emergency) but play in the National singles. Reserve players **fund their own trip** to the Nationals.

6. **Masters' team** will comprise the **4** best qualified from the Masters' Championships. To be eligible for QEBF or Zone assistance, such Masters' team members must have participated fully in the trialing system. Assistance scale: 1=100%; 2=50%; 3&4=25% of levy assistance.

7. Two wild card spots **may** be available for the Zone squad each year. To be eligible a player must:

- a. have played in the State team once in the previous two years; and
- b. have been unable to compete in sufficient ranking tournaments due to travel or living area conditions.

Such admissions will be made only after **association recommendation** and **committee approval**. Wild cards are no longer additional to Squad numbers.

Wild card **entrants** are required to pay the full amount of **entry fees** for every zone ranking tournament missed.

8. **Major Events:** State finals for Open, Women's and Masters will involve **8 participants** based on the pro-rata membership **ratio**. The host zone to take up any spot not filled.

ZONE EVENTS

1. For SEQ Players of **Country v City B & C** grades above a certain % (66.66%) **must play a grade higher for all state events in the following year.**

2. The **Player of the Carnival** award will go to the player on most wins: in the event of a tie, the player on the highest percentage; and if still tied, the player winning the most frames in the final/s playoff if applicable. To be **eligible** for Player of the Carnival a player may only miss a maximum of 3 frames, not all from the same match.

3. SEQ Team entries to the Country v City event will not be accepted unless the **full affiliation fees** for an Association are paid by the **April meeting** of QEBF.

4. **Team names, relevant grade lists and fees** must be forwarded to the **Tournament Director** (fees to the Treasurer) by the end of the second week in **May**.

5. SEQ – unruly behaviour **penalty system**

Any verified report or Committee witnessed example will incur a **yellow** card penalty.

Two such yellow cards in a calendar year will incur a **fine of \$200** before any further participation in QEBF events. A **further breach** will warrant automatic **exclusion** from all events for that year with a **\$200 fine** for readmission to events of the following year.

JUNIOR EVENTS

1. Registered **juniors** in senior events pay **half** the entry fee.

2. In QEBF **Junior** Championships a player may only compete at his/her **own** age level and the **next level above**.
