

COVID SAFE INDUSTRY PLAN FOR FRASER COAST CUE SPORTS

Fraser Coast Cue Sports are adopting the Covid Safe Industry Plan issued by the Qld Government. A copy of the plan can be found at www.covid19.qld.gov.au/government-actions/covid-safe-businesses

A copy will also be available at the premises.

In addition, we would also like to add the following procedures that we have in place to ensure the safety of our members and visitors.

- We ask the players only attend the venue. If you are considering bringing a visitor or spectators please email <u>frasercoastcuesports@outlook.com.au</u> for approval first. This is a measure that we need to do to keep compliant with the numbers allowed in the pool hall at any one time.
- As there are 2 groups arriving on the same day, we ask that the second group do not enter the premises before being instructed to do so. We need to make sure that the first group has left first.
- CvC players will be able to sanitize their hands and sign in at the gazebo placed out the front. Please do not forget to sign out as well.
- All drinks and food must be consumed whilst sitting.
- To ensure social distancing there is a neutral zone for players to stand whilst awaiting their visit to the table.
- Chairs have been strategically placed to be compliant. Please do not remove from the cross.
- Do not shake hands or embrace your opponent before you start play. The new method is to touch elbows or tap your feet. We know this is hard for players to comply with, as we have been engaging in contact for so long and it has always been considered in the spirit of the game. But

we need to consider the safety of all our players and the whole of the community.

- Sanitizing wipes are available for players to clean the table, balls, triangle and jiggers when their match is over. Ready for the incoming team to use safely.
- Hand sanitizer is available throughout the pool hall and of we expect players to use it when they come in from the smoking area.
- There are wash basins in all toilet areas and players should always wash their hands before exiting.

General Rules for Fraser Coast Cue Sports

- Licenced drinking area is within the 3 areas designated inside. Alcohol must not be taken out to the smoking area or outside of the orange barricaded area. (The walkway between the 3 venues out the front.) Under no circumstances is anyone allowed to take or drink in the car park nor in their car in the car park. Anyone bringing alcohol into the pool hall that was not purchased within the premises will be asked to leave straight away and will not be welcome to finish the tournament.
- There will be food available, so players are not permitted to bring food into the venues.
- Smokers please familiarise yourself with the smoking areas available and do not smoke anywhere else. The front car park area is **NOT** a smoking area.
- It is quite likely that organisers will be playing pool as well and they are volunteers putting this event together to help you experience the best possible time ever. Please be considerate to all our helpers and remember the massive effort that has gone into making this event happen.
- So, to end this the only other requirement is that you have a great time and enjoy catching up with old friends and making new ones. Lets play
