Adopted for the A.E.B.F By-Laws

11. Dress Codes

- 11.1 The Host Association is responsible for ensuring that signage is erected at the Queensland Championships outlining dress requirements.
- 11.2 Spectators: "NO":
- Thongs
 - Singlets
 - Tattered or Dirty Clothing
 - Shorts (Except dress shorts and long socks)
- 11.3 Players and Officials:
- Males: Black Slacks, Collared Team Shirt and Black Dress Shoes.
 - Females: Black Slacks or Skirt, Team Shirt or Blouse and Black Dress Shoes.
 - Players must wear full Association uniform at all times when competing.
- 11.4 Definitions:
- Slacks: Does not include jeans, leggings and tracksuits etc.
 - Shoes: Does not include Running Shoes, Sandals, and Moccasins etc.
- 11.5 Any player not in their correct Association uniform is to be omitted from the Opening Ceremony.
- 11.6 Association Uniforms:
- Each Association should have the Event Logo on the Playing Shirt
- 11.7 Extreme Temperature:
- The Dress Code may be relaxed if extreme temperatures prevail
